# WATER - Gift of God, Source of Life

## Devon Churches Green Action Ecumenical Service – JPIC Chapel, Exeter Cathedral 22<sup>nd</sup> September 2007 – 12 noon

Water is a symbol of life. The Bible affirms water as the cradle of life, an expression of God's grace in perpetuity for the whole of creation (Gen 2:5ff). It is a basic condition for all life on Earth (Gen 1:2ff.) and is to be preserved and shared for the benefit of all creatures and the wider creation. What is the source of health and well0being and requires responsible action from us human beings, as partners and priests of Creation (Rom 8:19ff., Rev 22).
